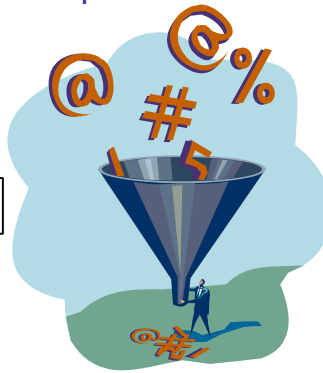
BASIC ELIGIBILITY SCREEN

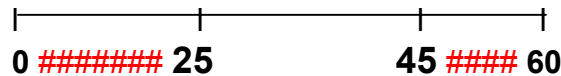
HOUSING SITUATION AND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE ASSESSMENT

Confirms eligibility and reviews:

- ◆ Employment / Income Potential
- ◆ Current Financial Status
- ◆ Housing and Legal History

Creates a numerical score (Score can be overridden with an explanation.)
